Having published more than 50 scientific papers in international journals, and with more than a decade spent as a research physiologist and lecturer in zoology, David brings extensive scientific knowledge and understanding to bear on all aspects of his productions.

David has produced and presented more than twenty broadcast documentaries and hosted 77 half-hour episodes of his own weekly national television series, David Smith's *Earthwatch*, on ABC TV for two years. David also wrote and presented numerous items on the Radio National Science Show and Occam's Razor.

Senior Researcher for the ABC/BBC series Nature of Australia, 'resident zoologist' on the Don Lane and Bert Newton Shows, David was for a time weatherman and environment specialist for Channel 7 Melbourne.

Author of six books, including two critically acclaimed Penguin eco-thrillers, David was also ghost writer for the 1100-page tertiary text *Biology*, published by McGraw-Hill. David was Associate Producer and Animation Supervisor on the large-format (IMAX) documentary Australia: land beyond time.

As Director of the Mind and Body Gallery at Melbourne Museum, David was instrumental in designing and developing a world-class gallery containing five exhibitions showcasing Australian research in anatomy and cell biology, biotechnology and bio-ethics.

Over the past decade David has specialized in the production of DVDs and online content for the health, education and community sectors. In 2016 David won the Victorian Community Historical Communication Award for the most outstanding local history project presented in a unique format: Duldig Studio Documentaries, Volume 1.

David established imaginACTION in 1987 as a company dedicated to taking imaginative ideas and converting them into reality.
